

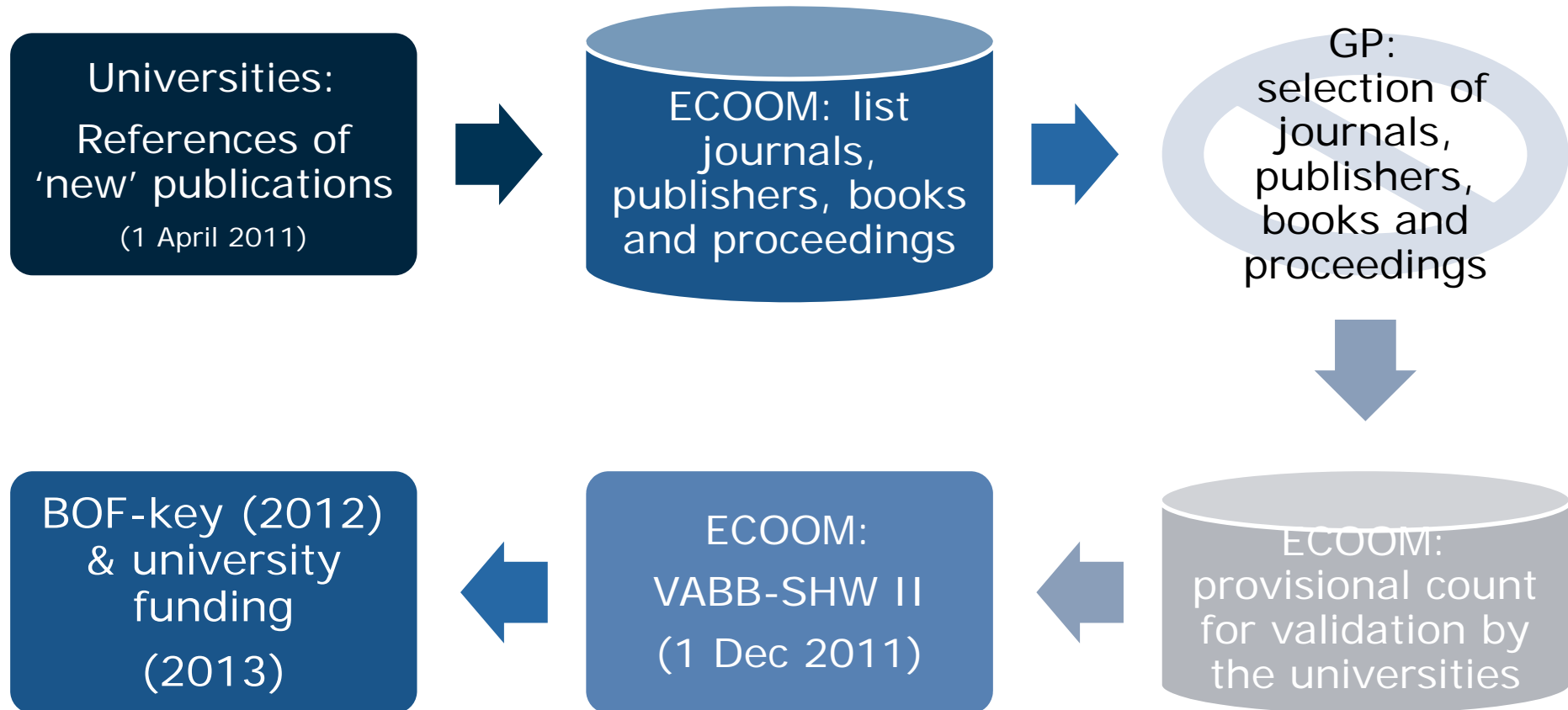

VABB II timeline



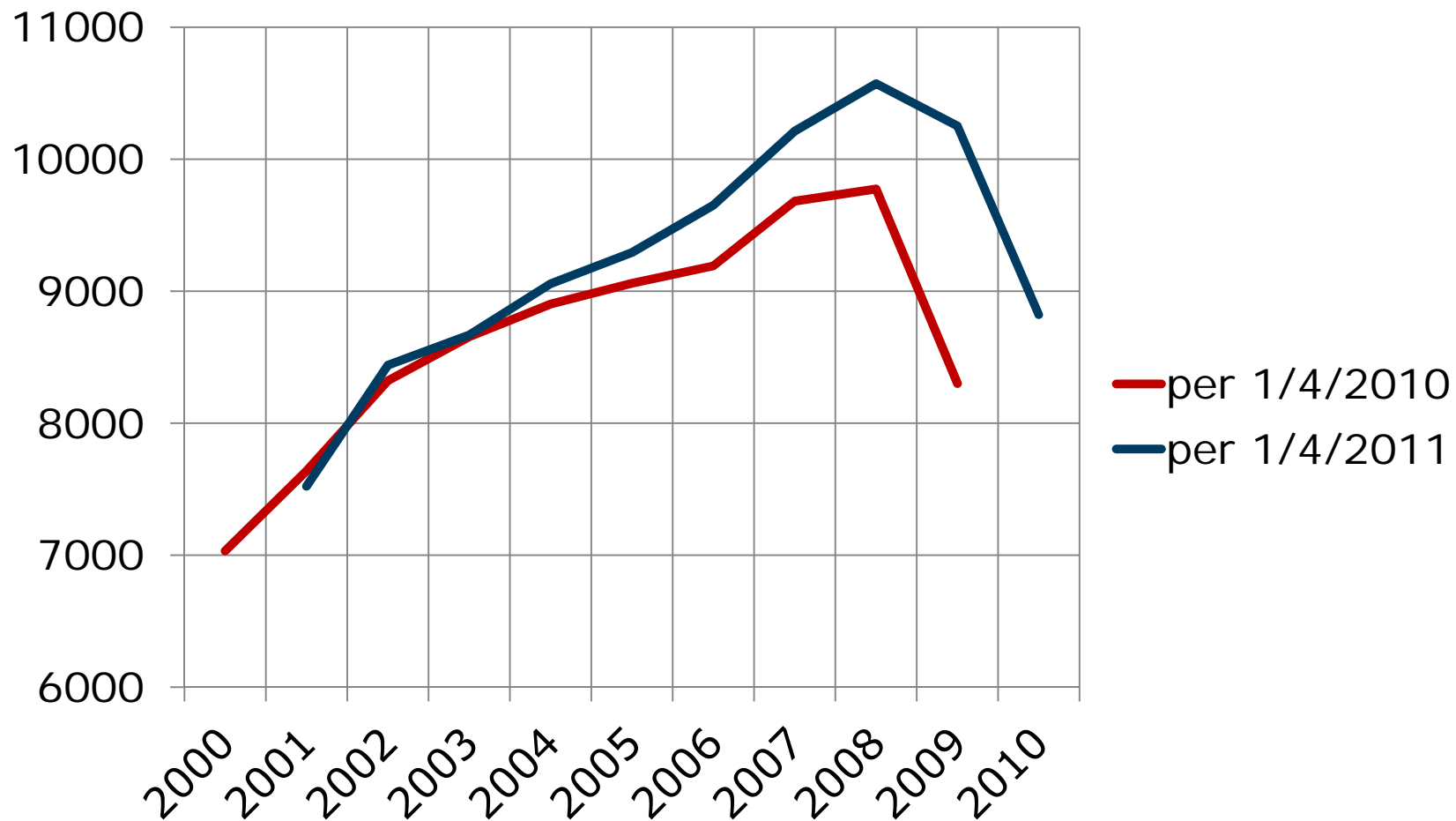

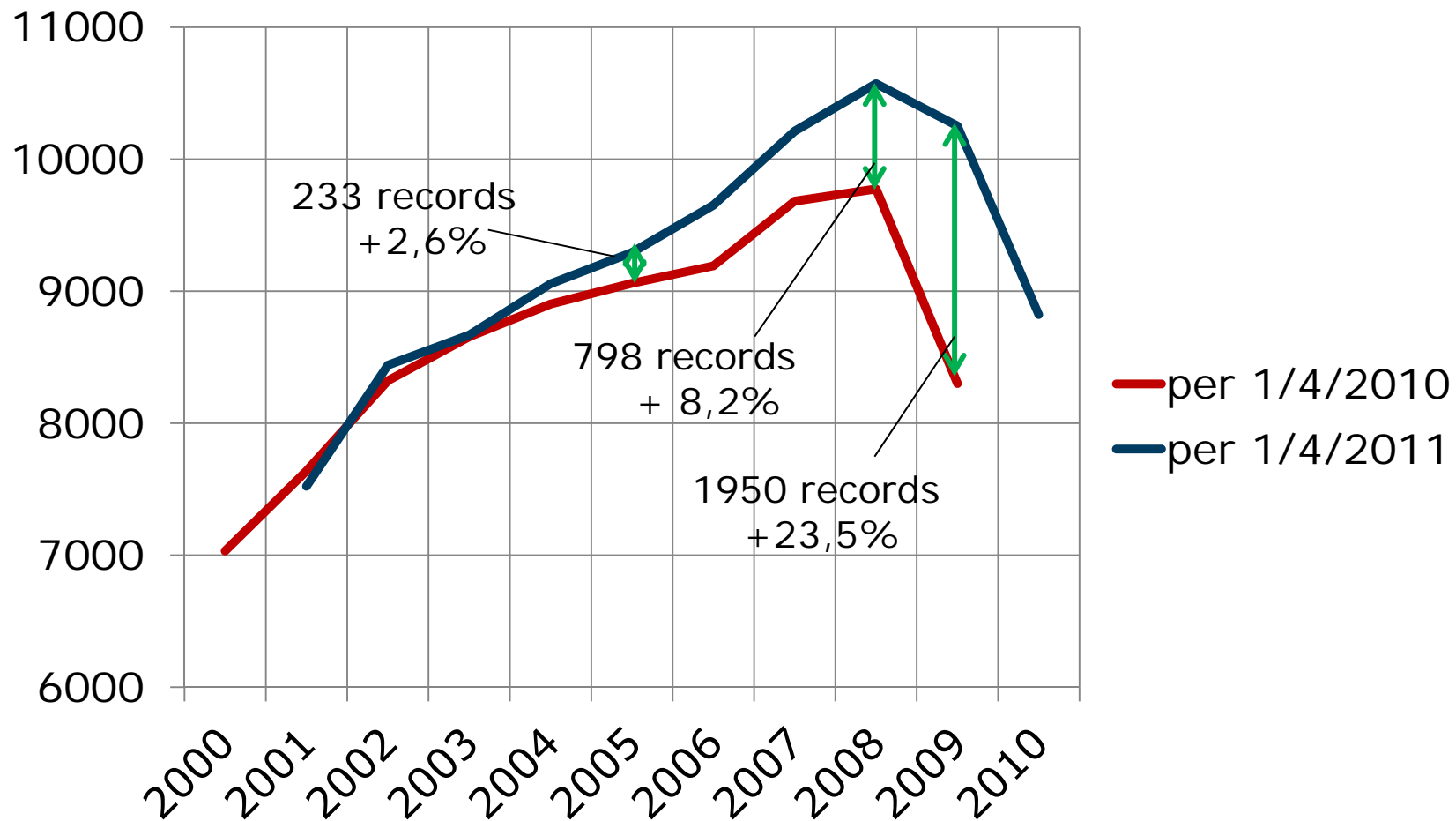


Records/year submitted to VABB



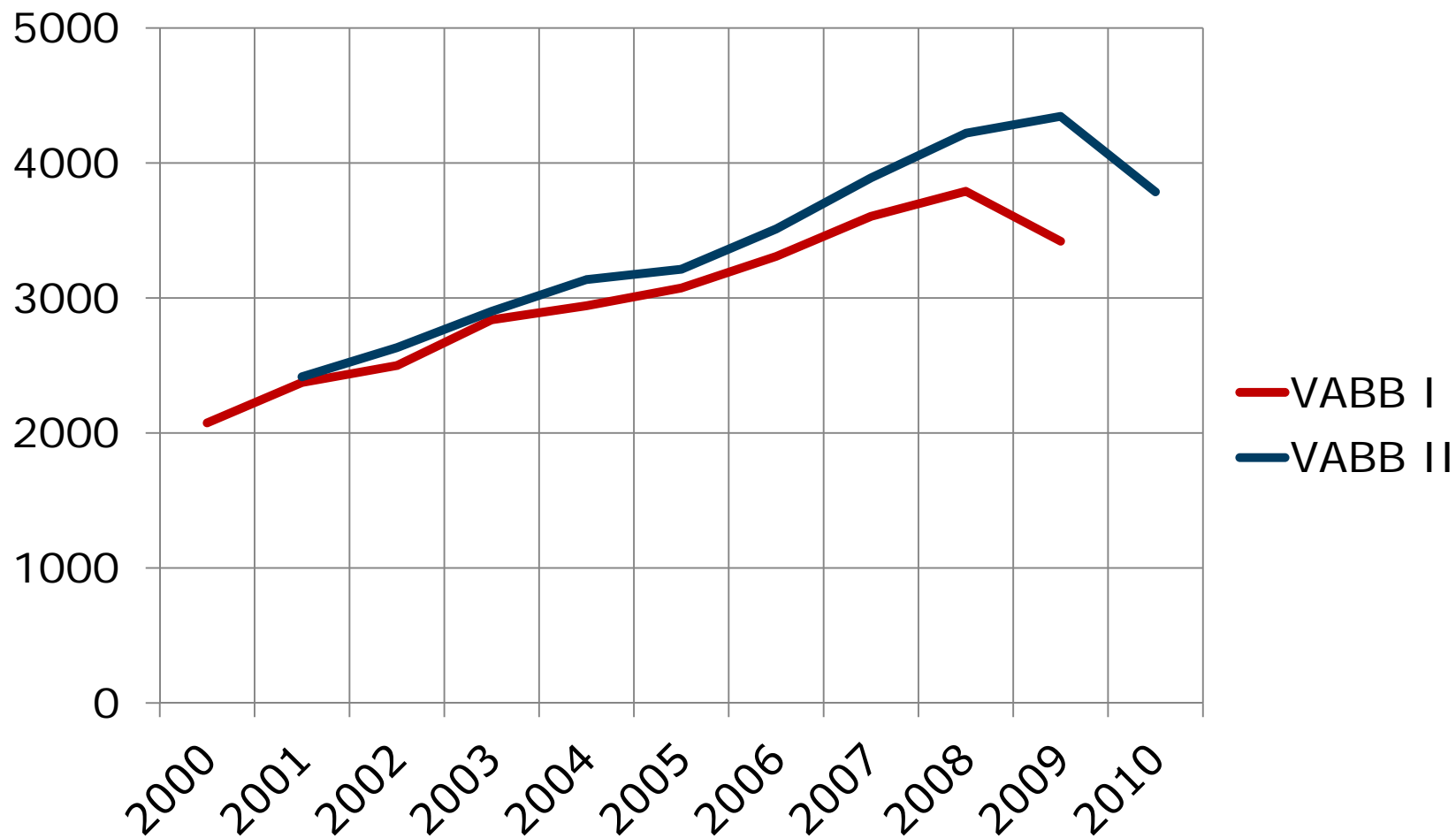


Records/year submitted to VABB



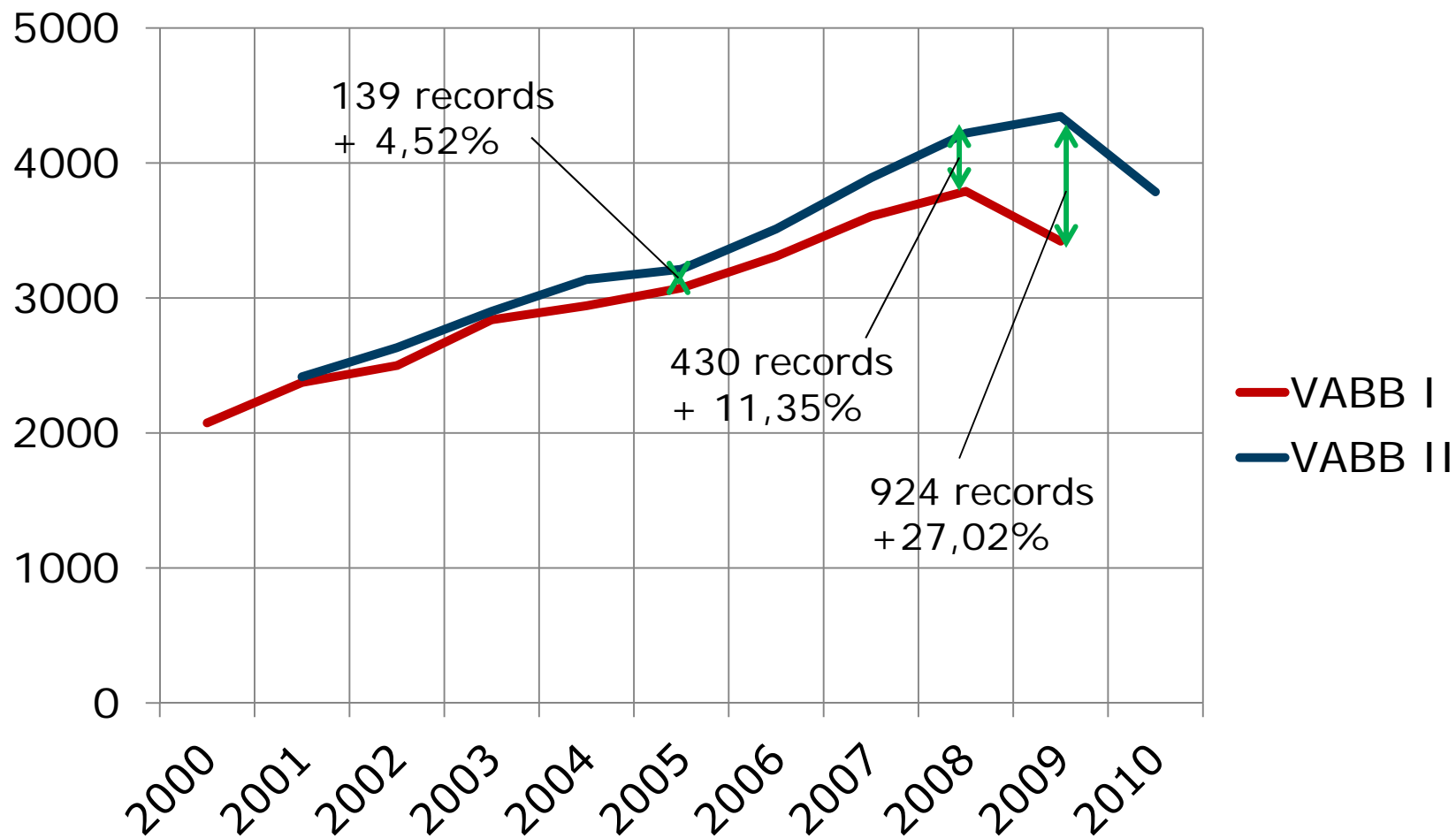


Publications included in VABB-SHW



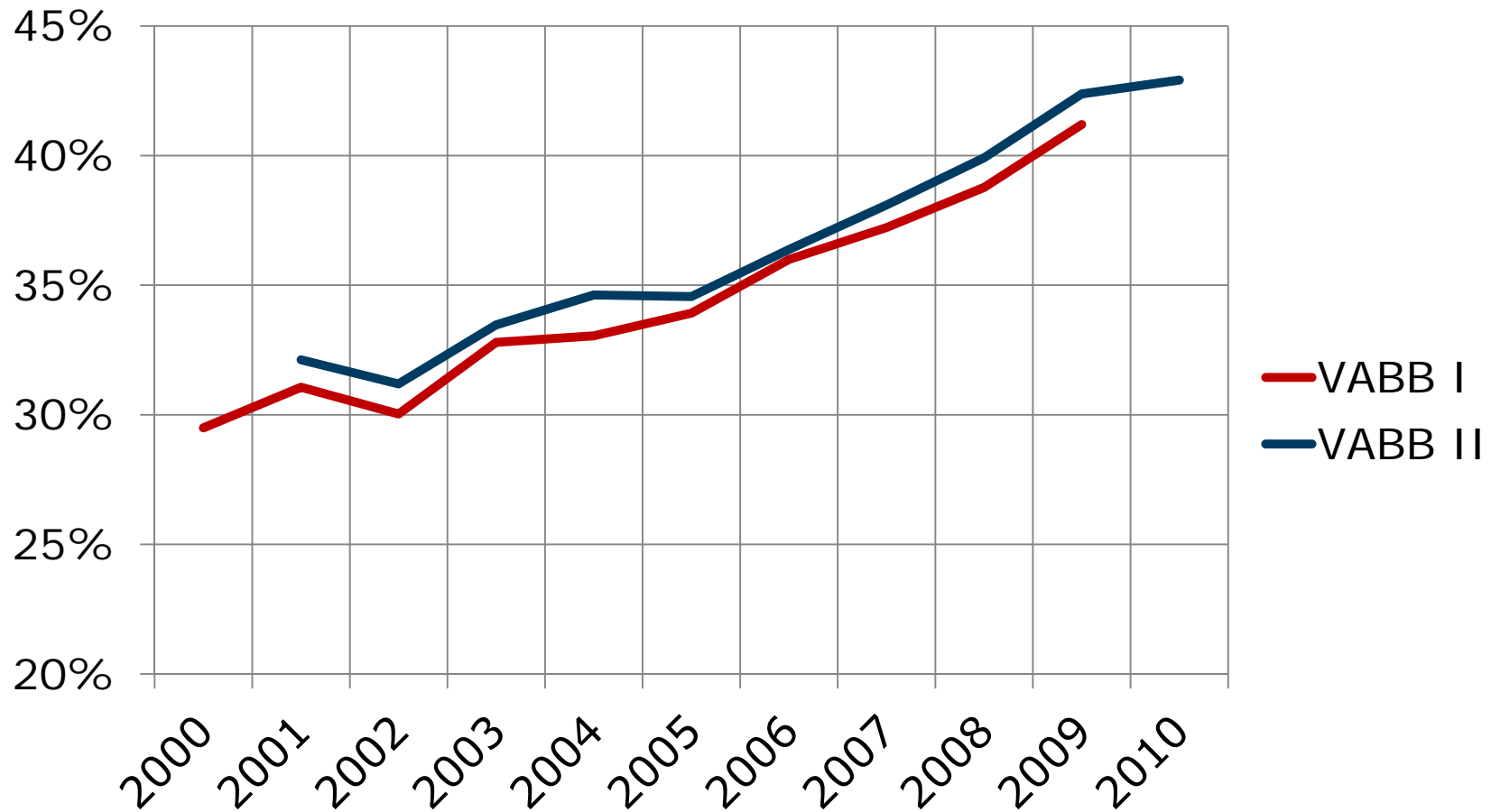


Publications included in VABB-SHW



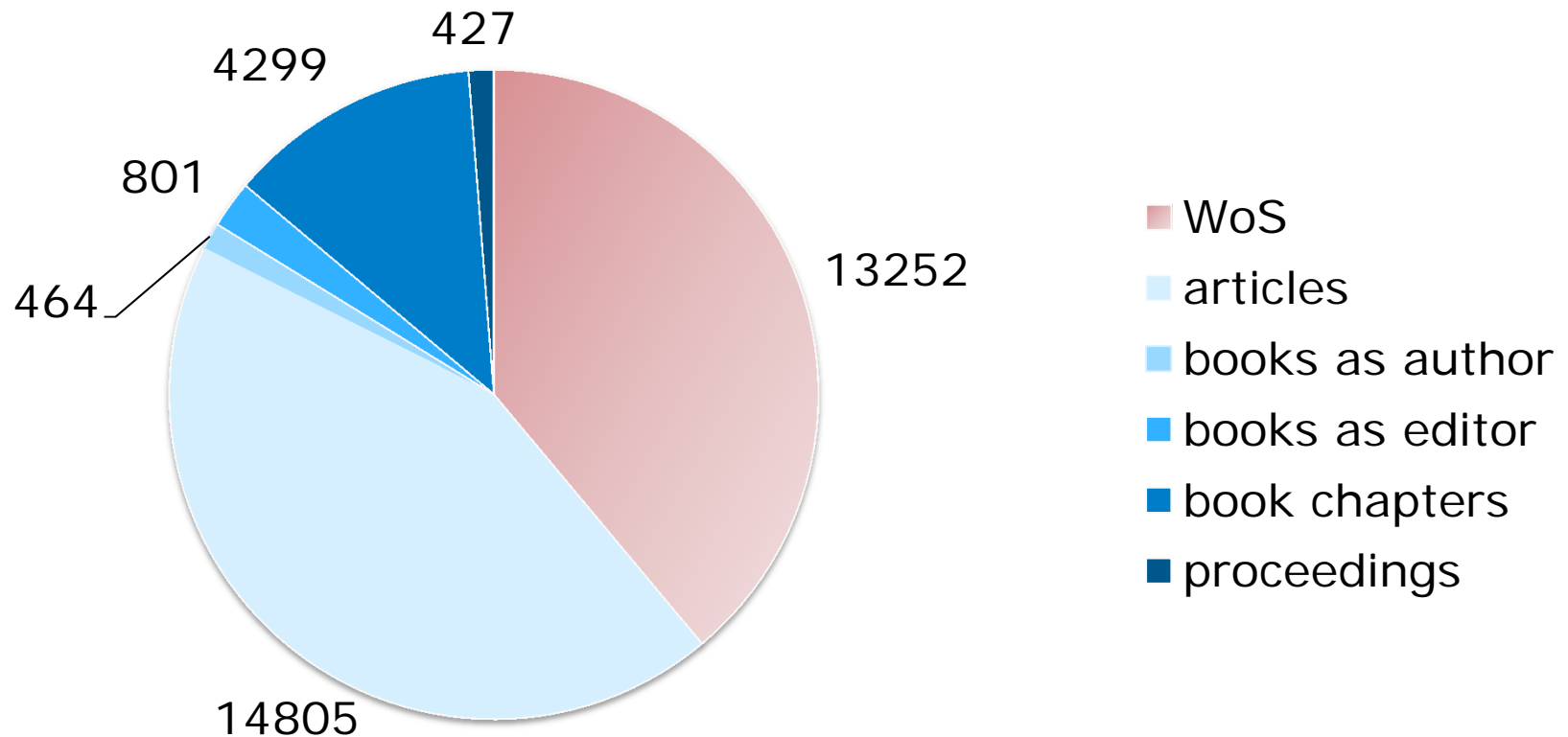


% publications included in VABB-SHW



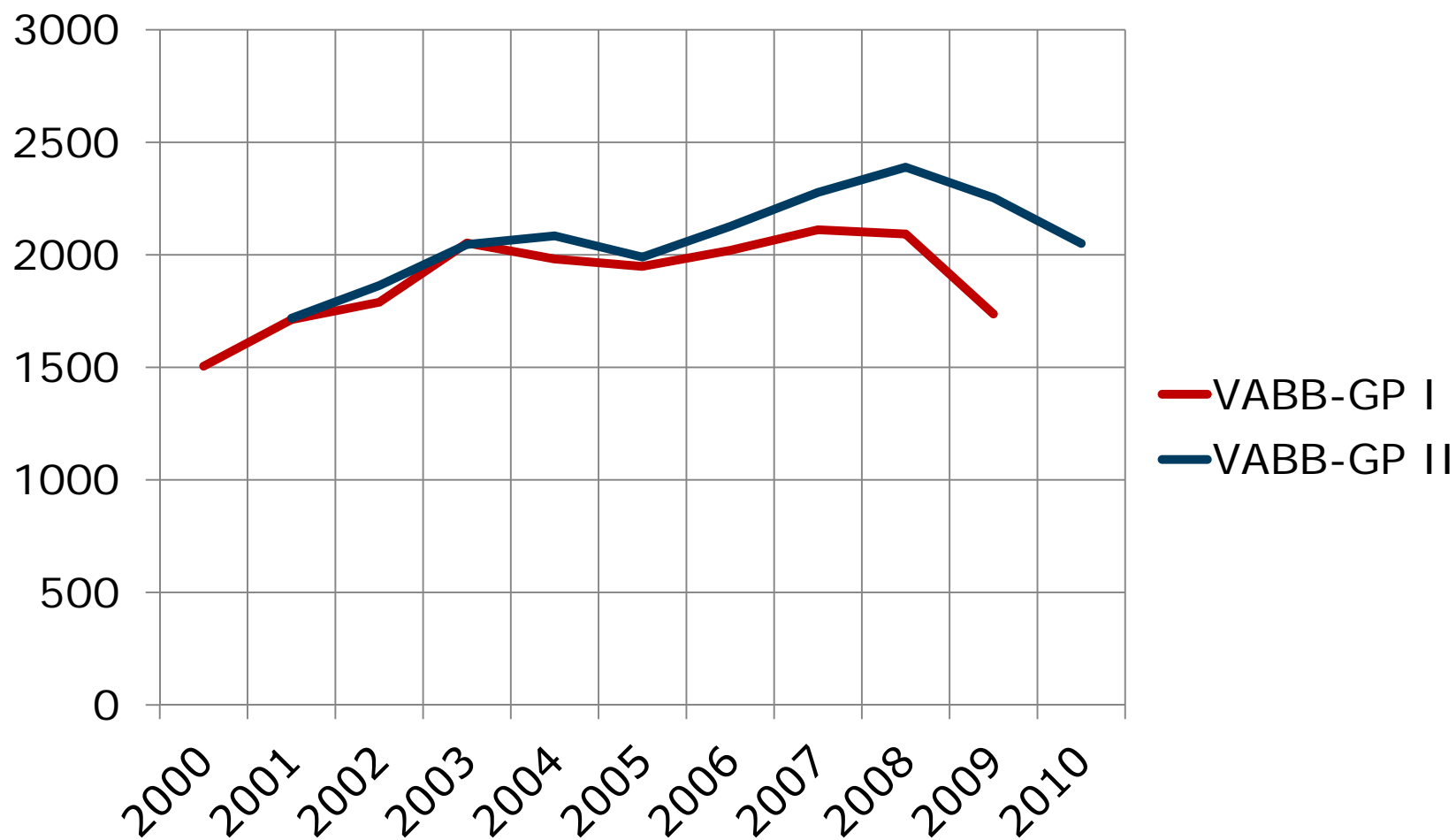


Publications included in VABB-SHW II



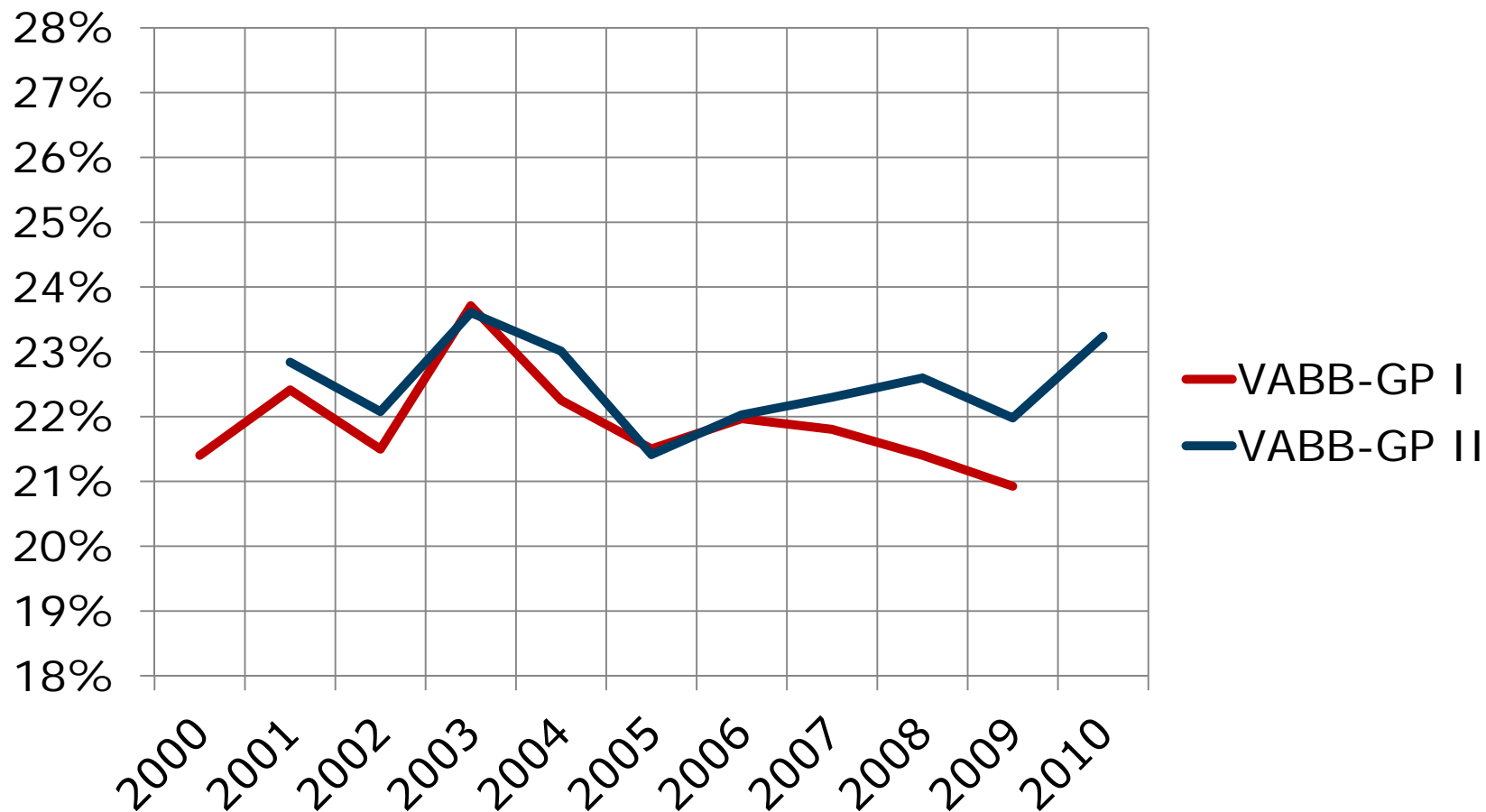


Publications included in VABB-GP



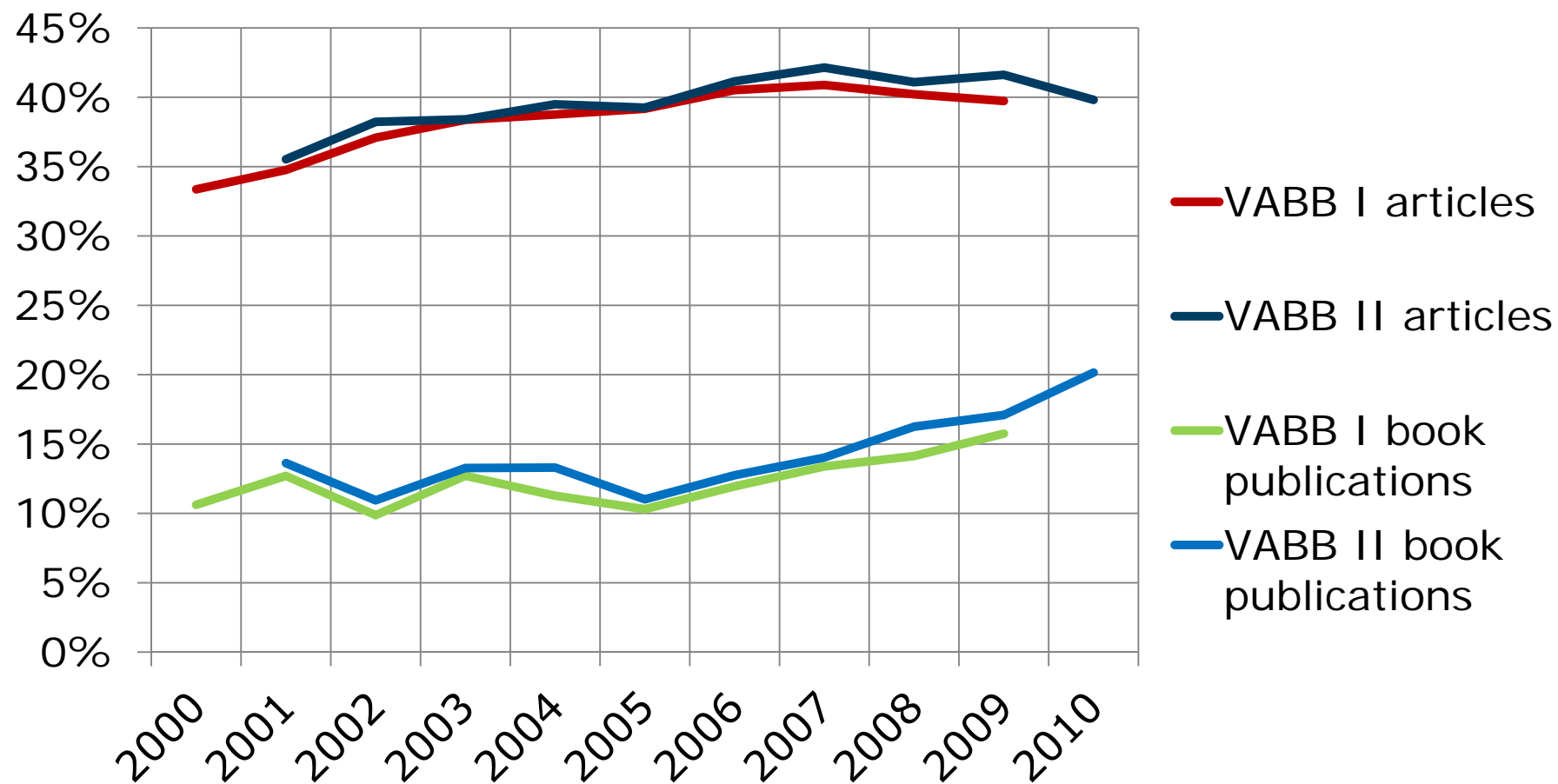


% publications included in VABB-GP



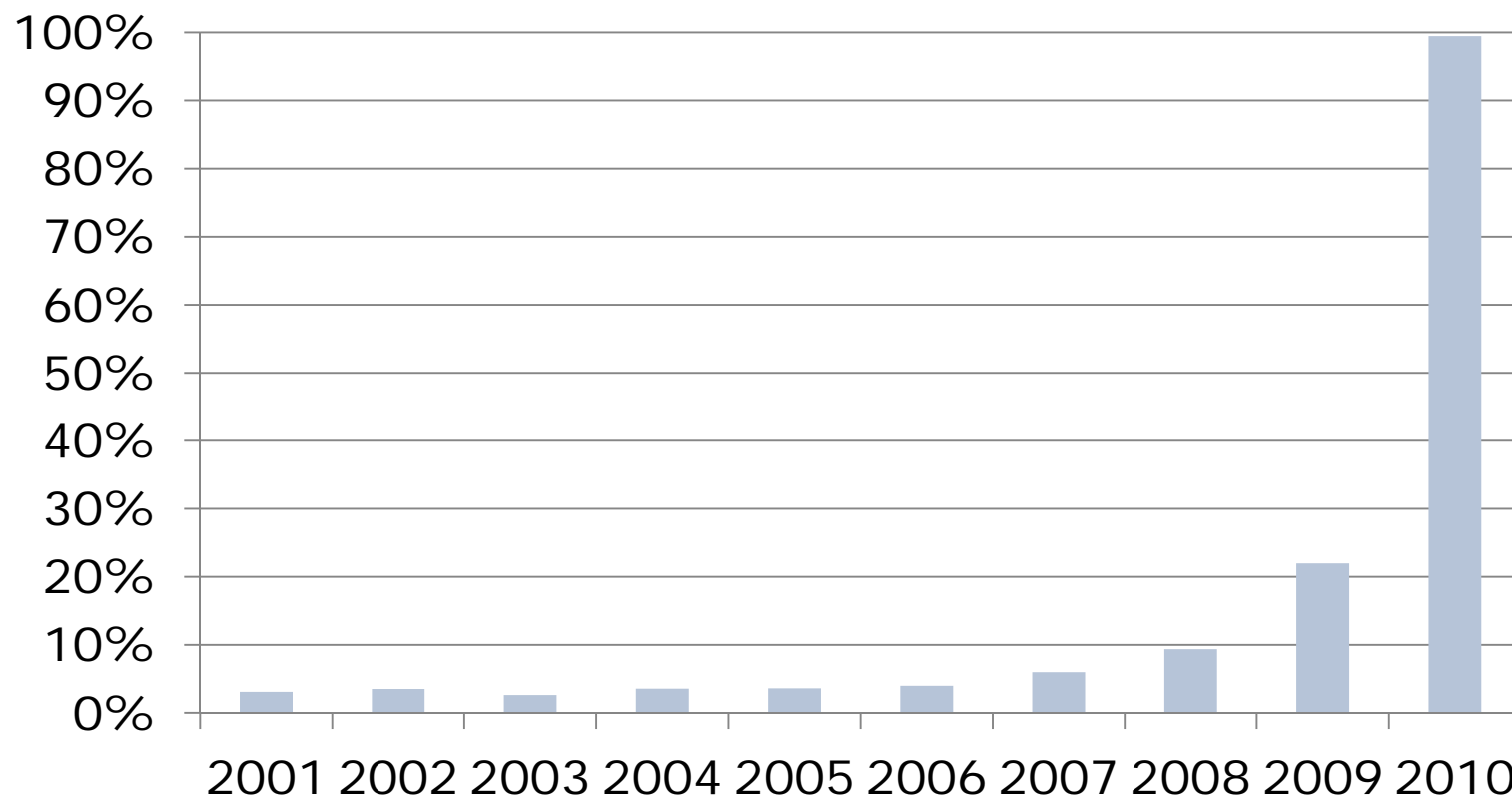


% articles and book publications included

Factors leading to approval of more articles (2001-2009)

- Errors in VABB I: 0%
- Revision of decisions regarding classification of journals: 16 journals / 148 articles / 1,00% of VABB-GP
- New and upgraded records in (previously) approved journals: 725 (5,46%) articles of VABB-GP

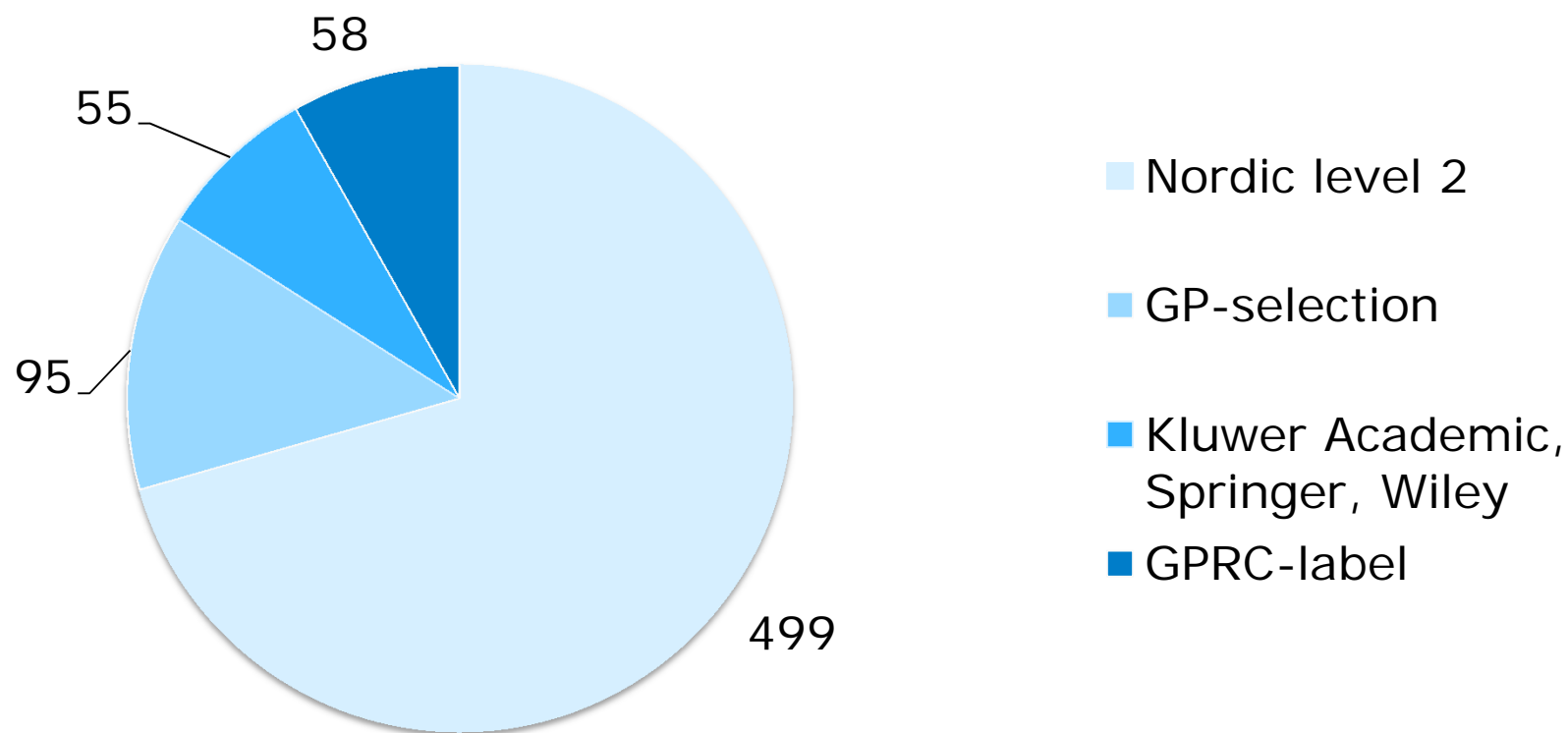


Factors leading to approval of more book publications (2001-2009)

- Errors in VABB I: 0%
- Revision of decisions regarding classification of publishers: 3 publishers (Kluwer Academic, Springer, Wiley) / 463 book publications / 9,53% of book pubs (between 6 and 15% per year)
- New and upgraded records: 277 (5,70%) book publications

Conclusions

- Increasing number of submitted publications, especially for 2008-2010
- Increasing percentage of publications approved for VABB-SHW II, mainly because of
 - Publishing more in WoS journals
 - Inclusion of more journals and publishers
 - Inclusion of specific book publications (GP-selection and GPRC-label)
